

# The 2024 NSSA Biennial Congress Call for Abstracts



The Names Society of Southern Africa (NSSA) in collaboration with the Faculty of Humanities at the University of Eswatini (UNESWA), is hosting the 23<sup>rd</sup> edition of the NSSA biennial Congress from 25-27 September 2024.

#### First call for abstracts

While it is common practice to associate names and naming with the disciplinary domains of linguistics and anthropology, onomasticians have pursued the import of names far beyond these domains. Names can be, and indeed, have been studied from positivist, constructivist, and interpretivist paradigms. This is evidence of the inter and transdisciplinary nature of the field of onomastics. Theories and practices within the ambit of onomastics include empirical Geo-spatial approaches to location, philosophical engagements on names, reference and identity, linguistic aspects on the structure and meanings, etymological and historical aspects, cultural and pragmatic aspects, geo-political and legal discourses, colonial and decolonial discourses, sociological and religious significance, psychological effects of names, business and branding, critical approaches and literary onomastics to name some.
